Instructions to authors

Submitted papers should not have been previously published nor be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. Any instances of plagiarism will be automatically declined, and the said authors will be prevented from resubmitting to the conference. The conference will accept unpublished dissertations /papers that were not previously published in conference proceedings so long as these are revised according to our submission guidelines below, the conference allows authors full copyright over their published articles.

Manuscripts should be submitted for the (the conference) on E-mail (edlf@edlf-eg.org) or WhatsApp ([00201004474574](https://www.whatsapp.com/business/profile/00201004474574)) all papers submitted are first reviewed by the Editorial board to check whether they are appropriate for the conference readership and in accordance with the editorial policy and aims of the conference. Following this, the paper is sent to anonymous reviewers for blind review. All papers submitted to the conference must conform to the submission guidelines for an appropriate review, the conference advises that the approximate review time takes between 2-3 weeks.

Submission Guidelines

- The title page should only include the title. Prepare a second 1-page document that contains the full names, institutional affiliation, country, e-mail addresses, and contact numbers of the author/s. This single page will be uploaded as a supplementary file in step 4 of the submission process.
- Authors should prepare manuscripts according to **APA style** and follow **the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (6th edition)**. Typing instructions and instructions on preparing tables, figures, references, metrics, and abstracts appear in the Manual.
- Figures and tables should be placed within the manuscript and not in an appendix.
- All manuscripts must be double-spaced, using Times New Roman font (**size 12**).
- The length of articles, excluding appendices and references, should not exceed (**13 page**). We may make exceptions in some cases.
- All manuscripts must be accompanied by a title and abstract, while the abstract is limited to no more than **200 word**).
- At the end of the abstract, three to six key words not used in the title should be provided.





Basic Guidelines

- **Title page** (full names, institutional affiliation, country, e-mail address, contact numbers of the author/s.)
- **Abstract** (200 words maximum).
- **Introduction** (should be comprehensible to the general reader; give a clear statement of the purpose of the paper and provide relevant context to support the basis for the paper and the significance of the work; do not exhaustively review the literature)
- **Method** (Method' section, give a clear description of the study and how it was carried out; specifically describe the Procedure and materials used, so the study can be replicated; the subsections, with brief content descriptions, in order, are.
 - **Participants** (describe the sample: how many participants, how they were recruited. Provide basic demographics (age and SD, sex distribution, etc.)
 - **Measures** (each subsection here should describe one questionnaire or interview or objective observation. Include details of the origin of the measure, the number of items and subscales, format of responses, scoring and known psychometric qualities)
 - **Procedure** (explain how the experiment was carried out. Who tested participants, where were they tested or observed, etc)
 - **Statistical Analysis** (describe the analyses applied to the data. It is helpful if you arrange this section to be coherent with the hypotheses)
- **Results** (results should be presented precisely and should not contain material that is appropriate in the discussion)
- **Discussion** (emphasize the new and important aspects of the study and conclusions derived from the study)
- **References** as per APA guidelines.
- **Appendices** (if necessary)

References should be cited in the text by author and year of the publication e.g. (hresh, 2020) or hashim (2020) In case there are more than one author, the rule is as follows:

Citing a reference with two authors:

- Hazem and Hashim (2020) stated that...
- or (Hazem and Hashim, 2020)

Citing a reference with three authors or more:

- Hashim et al. (2020) stated that...
- or (Hashim et al., 2020)
